### **Dear Little Bealings Resident**

We hope by now you have heard about the introduction of a Parish Council Neighbourhood Plan for Little Bealings.

The process of drafting a Neighbourhood Plan was launched in November 2023 and is being drawn up by a working group of residents and parish councillors.

The group and the Parish Council wants you all to have your voice heard.

This survey will provide us with important information and will help us ensure that the Plan is drawn up with reference to, and reflects, the aspirations of Little Bealings' residents.

#### Why does Little Bealings need a Neighbourhood Plan?

The government has a plan to build many new homes across the country.

The East Suffolk Local Plan does not identify the important local characteristics and features in our village that should be protected from development.

A Neighbourhood Plan allows us to decide where we would like any new homes to be built and identify important features that should be protected.

A Neighbourhood Plan covers things that need planning permission and can cover a range of themes, such as:

- Where new housing would be allowed
- What existing facilities should be protected, or new ones provided
- Protecting historically important sites
- Protecting our countryside and wildlife habitats
- Providing guidance on the design of new development

When complete, the Neighbourhood Plan will be used by East Suffolk Council when they make decisions about planning applications in the parish.


