# LITTLE BEALINGS NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN YOUTH SURVEY



### Help shape the future of our village

Little Bealings has decided to prepare a neighbourhood plan for the village.

A neighbourhood plan is a document which will be used by East Suffolk Council when deciding planning applications for things like new homes and other buildings. By answering this questionnaire, you are playing an active part in how buildings and community projects in our village will be implemented over the next 15 or so years.

#### Why does Little Bealings need a neighbourhood plan?

The government has a plan to build many new homes across the country. The rules governing how planning applications are decided in respect of Little Bealings do not currently identify the important local features in our village that should be considered when deciding those applications.

A neighbourhood plan allows us to decide where we would like any new homes and other buildings to be built, and to identify important features that should be protected.

A neighbourhood plan can cover a range of themes, such as:

- Where new housing would be allowed
- What existing facilities should be protected, or what new facilities should be provided
- Protecting historically important sites
- Protecting our countryside and wildlife habitats
- Providing guidance on how new developments should look

#### How you can help

This survey will provide us with some important information and the opinions of young people in the village will, along with a survey that all the adults will complete, help us put together a draft neighbourhood plan. We currently aim to consult with you on the draft plan in early 2025.
